

Did you know that your property drains to Long Lake? We need your help to keep the lake clean!

Join us on Tuesday, Aug. 24, 6:30-8pm, to learn more.

Carnelian-Marine-St. Croix Watershed District is conducting a study to identify sources of runoff pollution to Long Lake. So far, the lake is relatively healthy, but a gradual build-up of phosphorus and sediment from runoff could eventually make the water turn murky and algae-ridden.

At this neighborhood meeting, we will provide a brief overview of research planned and underway, and describe types of landscaping and runoff treatments that might be used to protect the lake. We also want to hear your goals and concerns for the lake so that we can work cooperatively to keep Long Lake clean.
